## Sensational for me

A small implant freed Kurt Bösch from his long standing reflux. If he had to have the procedure again, he would do it in an instant.



By chance, when Kurt Bösch saw a TV programme about acid reflux, he was immediately intrigued. "The programme featured a man who had exactly the same problems I was suffering from." This patient had already had two operations for reflux using the classic method, fundoplicatio, which did not bring the relief he had hoped for. Numerous people in Kurt Bösch's group of friends would also complain about similar problems with reflux. "All I can say is that you should definitely discuss this procedure with your doctor!".
